Eligibility for The Next Generation Award

- Nominees must have been 18 or under, and a resident of Nassau or Suffolk County while serving in a volunteer capacity within the past five years.
- The Next Generation Award will be awarded to a special Long Island youth who has made a significant impact on the lives of others through a commitment to community service and philanthropy.
- Self-nomination is permitted. All nominations must be accompanied with two professional references.

Selection Process

Long Island leaders including not-for-profit agencies, businesses, media, public service sectors and the academic community will serve on the panel of judges that select nominees for The Next Generation Award. All decisions are final. Inductees will be notified in December, the formal induction ceremony will be February, 2012. Winners must sign a release agreeing to their photos, bios and any other related information being published in the associations program. Media will also be notified.

Volunteer Categories

1. Children & Youth Services- Building self-esteem, mentoring others, and ensuring the safety and well-being of children and young adults.	7. Health- Contributing to the well-being of people through health and mental health services.
2. Cultural Arts- Enriching the soul through art, creative writing, dance, music, and theater.	8. Homelessness- Providing emergency shelter, transitional and permanent housing.
3. Education- Offering knowledge, skills, and talents to enhance the abilities of others.	9. Hunger- Providing emergency food aid and advocacy on behalf of those who are hungry.
4. Emergency Services- Saving lives and building safer communities.	10. Philanthropy- Giving the gift of time and/or money to support your community.
5. Environment- Protecting our land, water, air, wildlife and domestic animals.	11. Seniors- Providing support to the elderly population through visitation, recreation, and homebound assistance.
6. Family Support- Assisting, strengthening, and empowering families.	12. Special Needs- Addressing the needs of physically challenged, learning and developmentally disabled individuals.
